*The past tense is a verb tense used to describe actions that have already happened. It is generally formed by adding -ed to the base form of regular verbs, while irregular verbs often have unique past tense forms.*

##### 2. List two verbs and provide their past tense forms. (2 points)

- Verb: walk - Past: walked
- Verb: go - Past: went

- a) She read a book.
- b) They went to school every day.
